## ARISE Ministry School

#### **Full Time Courses**

We offer courses for 1, 2 or 3 years. These courses provide an environment where students are challenged to grow in their schools and operate with increased effectiveness in ministry. Whilst practical, task-based work is a key focus for any student - an even greater importance is placed on spiritual input. Worship and discipleship are an integral part of the programme, where students are ministered to by ARISE pastors and leaders. Students will have both a major and minor area of service. Each student will have a supervisor and a mentor that they will meet with regularly. The supervisor will manage their workload and provide opportunities to grow in their skills. Student mentors will help them grow spiritually and provide guidance and support as they grow in their ministry experience. Each day in the office is varied and offers new opportunities for learning and growth. The year runs from February to December.

### **Full Time Courses**

#### **Academic Courses**

#### Certificate in Christian Ministries

Year 1 - Level 4

Prerequisites: Demonstration of literacy through NCEA Level 2.

The Certificate is an entry-level programme for those who haven't studied at a tertiary level and/or would like to learn the basics of Christianity. This course includes a Practical Ministry Internship and covers topics of Discipleship, Encountering the Bible, Theology and Christian Belief.

The certificate is run in association with Laidlaw College.

#### **Diploma in Christian Studies**

Year 1 or 2 - Level 5

Prerequisites: At least a Merit Endorsement at NCEA Level 3.

The Diploma is equivalent to a first-year university level programme for those who have previously studied and would like to learn the basics of Christianity. The topics include Formation, Theology, Faith in Action and Mission, Church and Community and a practical Leadership Internship.

We also offer courses that lead on from Level 5 in association with Laidlaw College.

#### **Practical Course Option**

#### Certificate in Christian Ministries

Year 1, 2 & 3

Prerequisites: There are no prerequistes for this course.

The Practical course allows students to gain ministry experience in an environment where students are challenged to grow in their skills and operate with increased effectiveness for ministry. In the Diploma and Certificate courses, students will be allocated a study day. For those within the practical stream, students will exchange this day for a practical day. This allows students to have bigger portfolios where they can use the skills they are learning in a fast-paced office environment, often alongside a team. Identical to the Certificate and Diploma programme, students will have a supervisor and mentor that they will meet with regularly. We recommend first years complete the Certificate or Diploma Course option and then continue onwards to the Practical Stream within their second and third years.

### **Part Time Course**

#### **Online Night School Course**

Our night school is for those who are in full-time careers or who are busy parents. Our night school provides an environment where students can learn from our ARISE teachers and pastors midweek and then practically outwork what they have learnt in their area of service throughout the week. During this course, students will learn how to lead with increased effectiveness in ministry. Each Tuesday, students will have two one hour sessions — the first session will be based on Ministry Practicals with the second session having a focus on the Bible and Theology.

In the Ministry Practicals stream, students will learn about growing healthy teams, discipleship, pastoral care, evangelism, principles of Godly leadership, how to use their own God-given gifts and how release others into their God-given gifts, hearing from the Holy Spirit, spiritual disciplines and so much more. In our Bible and Theology stream students will learn Bible Interpretation, Pentecostal Theology & Parables and Gifts of the Spirit. During Friday and Sunday services, students will build and lead teams in their chosen area of service to see them released into a new level of leadership and effectiveness in ministry. This course is made up of two semesters which can be completed within one year or by completing each semester in different years.

#### Weekly commitment

Every Tuesday night from 7–9pm online and serving in a Friday or a Sunday team.
